Welcome/Greetings/Introductions-

Mr. White, Executive Director thank the committee for their work throughout the year

Points of Emphasis:

- 1. Officials—Issues (laps, recording, replace,)
 Committee agreed that meet management needs to rotate officials and if necessary replace.
- 2. Backup Camera/lap top for the finish line system.

Kyle Austin is considering purchasing a separate camera and computer as backup.

- 3. High Jump Area—a lot of discussion about this.
 - Invest in drying material
 - Summer project to seal the HJ floor area. Quotes to be attained by TRS District
- 4. Classifications for non-public schools—Chris Threston who sits on this NJSIAA Committee Reported on the classification committee work including the following:
 - a) Co-ops for group 3 & 4 track programs
 - b) Separation of Gender only schools
 - c) Non Public Entries--Earlier Due Date
- 5. Language and clarification:
 - Advancement from the Groups to the MOC—seed upgrade language will be emphasized in Rules & Regulations.
 - Language for undergarments—language will be added regarding modesty of attire.
 - Uniform wristband lettering—NFHS Rule Modification for the Spring of 2018.
 Lettering must be with the limitations of the rule modifications.
 - Venue change language—Will be added to Rules & Regulations. Example: HJ
 Area can be moved if all coaches whose athletes are involved in that event agree to the move.
 - Spikes---continued violation could lead to exclusion from future meets. Agreed!!

- Check in time by coaches for athletes—Meet Management will develop in a time Schedule for coaches to check their athletes into events.
- Shot Put Cards—will be used instead of paper print out sheets.
- 6. 2019 Calendar of meets—see attachment!
- 7. Showcase Events: discussion of event entry procedure. Language will be developed by Meet Management and Mile Split for the Showcase events.
- 8. Additional Items for 2019.
 - 1) Shore Coaches will donate a performance board for the Shot Put (Thank U Steve)
 - 2) Starting blocks will be used in the Sectional Finals of the 55 Hurdles and 55 dash—only.
 - 3) Toms River will move the announcer to a different location so the announcer can see
 The start of each race and not conflict with the starters commands.
 - 4) Meet Management and the TRS District are considering an award stand for the MOC Medal Ceremony
 - 5) A ONE YEAR Pilot to run the Showcase 4 X 800 after the 4 X 400. Approved!!
 - 6) TRS District will add a Clock to the top of the announcement board.
 - 7) TR Schools will look into renting trailer type port-pits. Stay tuned.
 - 8) Alley Seeding for 400 Meter and 4 X 400 relay for the last TWO HEATS—7 entries Seeds 1,2 (Lanes 3-4), Seeds 3-4 (Lanes 5-6), seeds 5,6,7 (Lanes 1-2))
- 9. Email correspondences-
 - 1) Discussion about new format to advance to Winter MOC—tabled for the future.
 - 2) Discussion about moving the MOC to Ocean Breeze. MOC will remain as a two day meet At the bubble for at least next year.
 - 3) Concept of meet standards for entries was reviewed and not well received.
 - 4) 8 names will remain as the standard for entry.
 - 5) A cleaner method of declaring competitors will be developed by meet management.
 - 6) A discussion about having athletes declare their intention ahead of time was rejected.
 - 7) Mile split will look into a flat track conversion for seeding. NO promises.
- 10. Media Input-We thanked Robert for his outstanding work and all he has done to promote NJ Track/XC!!
- 11. We also say good bye to long time Track & Field Guru, Lou Farulo who is officially retiring. He has seen some amazing student-athletes in his long tenure and has witnessed the tremendous growth of our wonderful sport. He has had a lot to do with it. He will be missed.
