Colleen suggested that we go from three entries per event to two per team per event. Also Colleen discussed how we should handle the individual athletes whose school doesn't have a team.. Colleen made three suggestions 1. Have them enter the sectionals and not count towards the team score. 2. Have them enter in the Groups meet and also not let them count towards team score. 3. Have them only be able to compete in the MOC. Colleen took questions and feedback on the three options and summarized by saying that the NJSIAA would discuss with the committee and come up with and option on how to handle these students. Colleen stressed that no club times would be used to seed for any of the meets.
